

*I found my answer at BLK...*

64 yrs old lady was operated at one of the large hospitals in Chandigarh for prolapsed rectum (In this diseases whole of rectum comes out through the anal opening). In this surgery a mesh (piece of synthetic sheet) is put around the rectum to keep rectum in the abdomen. She soon after the surgery developed complication, where mesh perforated into the rectum and made her life miserable. She started passing huge amount of blood and pus from the anal opening. She used to get sever pain in abdomen. She went back to doctors who advised her to undergo permanent stoma (change of stool passage). She was frightened & became psychologically very depressed.

She was than referred to BLK Hospital where team of doctors assessed her & took her case up as a challenge. Laparoscopic surgery was done by G I Surgery team lead by Dr. Deep Goel & Dr. V P Bhalla and her normal stool passage was saved. She was walking next day and eating food. She was discharged happily on 4th post operative day.
